



7096 Installation Instructions for Apple Macintosh Computers

Compatibility Requirements

Intel processor running OS X 10.4 or later

First Install FTDIUSBSerialDriver after completing the driver installation Install 7096.dmg.

Connect the 7096 controller to a USB 2.0 socket. Please note that USB sockets on an Apple Keyboard are a lower powered USB 1.0 socket and will not work with the 7096

Start the application labeled Aquarium that was installed by 7096.dmg.

The 7096 programming module should come up on screen and indicate on the bottom of the screen "Interface Detected....."

Should the screen indicate "No Interface Detected" double check that the driver was installed correctly and that your computer meets the compatibility requirements. Please double check that you are using an appropriate USB 2.0 socket and consider trying another socket. If this does not resolve the issue try shutting down the computer and trying again.
